4. Once payment is received, we will contact you to organise a suitable time for pick-up.

Note, some plants have limited availability and will be on a first-in basis. If a particular species is not available, where possible, we will suggest a suitable alternative species. Most plants are tubestock. The species list will be updated over time, as different species become available.
